Some of the materials included were the brain card, the S&S of PTL wallet card, a pregnancy wheel, PN pamphlets, BFG 101, the smoking QUIT-LINE and FA pamphlets. Three participants showed CO2 exposure when they blew into the smoke analyzer machine as follows: 2/0.5%; 7/1.2%; and 10/1.9%.
